Professor Vallipuram Kanagasingam becomes the 10th Vice Chancellor



Professor Vallipuram Kanagasingam was appointed as Vice-Chancellor of the Eastern University, Sri Lanka by His Excellency the President and assumed duties as the Vice-Chancellor on the 22nd of January, 2022.

Prof. Kanagasingam obtained his PhD from the Postgraduate Institute of Management of the University of Sri Jayawardenepura, Sri Lanka, and Master of Science in Management from the same University. With his appointment as the 10th Vice-Chancellor of the Eastern University, Sri Lanka, Prof. Kanagasingam becomes alumnus Vice-Chancellor appointed from the Faculty of Commerce & Management, Eastern University, Sri Lanka. Prof. Kanagasingam being an Alumnus of the Eastern University, Sri Lanka graduating in 1995, has worked tirelessly for the enhancement of the standards of the University.

Prof. Kanagasingam, has a number of research papers and articles to his name published in high-ranking national and international journals. He has authored several, books monographs and essays.

Prior to his appointment as the Vice-Chancellor of the Eastern University, Sri Lanka, Prof. Kanagasingam was the Rector of the Trincomalee Campus, Eastern University, Sri Lanka, Dean of the Faculty of Commerce and Management, Head of the Department of Management, Coordinator for the External Degree Programmes and holding many other key roles in the University, Society and the Nation. During his time as the Dean, Faculty of Commerce & Management, and the Rector of the Trincomalee Campus, Eastern University, Sri Lanka, he was instrumental in expediting the construction of the Faculty complex and many other new buildings in the Trincomalee Campus Premises as well.

Professor Kanagasingam with his appointment as the Vice Chancellor has many projects in the pipeline to be implemented such as the establishment of the Faculty of Engineering and many other innovative centers. Professor Kanagasingam will no doubt lead the university towards a new era of development and help the university to step into another milestone.

For the first time in two years, the Eastern University, Sri Lanka celebrated its General Convocation in person.

The previous convocations were held in a virtual reality mode for the last two years in view of the COVID 19 pandemic and the academic achievers were excited to see an in-person event once again on the 12th & 13th of March, 2022.

The Chief guests for the two day Convocation ceremony were the Senior Professor Chandana P Udawatte, the Vice Chairman of the University Grants Commission, Prof. K. Kapila C. K. Perera, the

Secretary to the Ministry of Education respectively on each day. Also in attendance were other dignitaries from the academic arena, industries and the government apart from the University Officials.

The Convocation began with a majestic and grand academic procession led by the University Cultural Troop and the Naathaswaram followed by the Lighting of Traditional Oil lamp by the Chief Guests and the Key Officials of the University. The formal proceedings began with presenting of Honourary Degrees, the Doctor of Science (Posthumous) to Late Prof. Subramaniam Raveenranath and the Master of Letters (Honoris Causa) to Mr. Seenithambi Gopalasingam. Then the Chancellor Dr. Velmurugu Vivekanantharajah delivered his Chancellor's address during which he motivated the students not to forget their value systems, work ethics and humanity.

This year a total of 1958 students and scholars graduated in various fields of studies, 135 Masters Degree, 1823 Bachelors Degrees of Fine Arts, Medicine, Nursing, Siddha Medicine, Science, Business Administration, Commerce, Management, Agriculture, Arts, Education, and Computer Science. The graduates and the audience were then enthralled by the rousing speech of the Chief Guests, Senior Professor Chandana P Udawatte and Prof. K. Kapila C.K.Perera to "Stand up and Start Up Sri Lanka", they invited the booming graduates to make use of the resources for enabling them for start-ups. They emphasized that contributing back to the community is being essential. In their brief and captivating addresses, they inspired the graduates and faculty of the Eastern University, Sri Lanka.

The Convocation ended with the National Anthem and the graduates bloomed in absolute glee.



Since its inception the Faculty of Health-Care Sciences, it has been committed to producing healthcare leaders of the highest quality and caliber. It has always been understood that the development of a student into a holistic professional requires to obtain a varied mix of skills and qualities.

In Sri Lanka the sole criteria for entry into the university system is academic excellence, this results in the unfortunate situation where quite often students although intelligent and talented lack the practical skills to manage real life problems. This has contributed to the downfall of the quality of graduates produced by state universities.

The Faculty of Health Care Sciences (FHCS) has always believed that although curriculum-based knowledge and skills are essential, extracurricular activities are also equally crucial for professional development. With this vision in mind the faculty has consistently promoted and supported all forms of extracurricular activities undertaken by the faculty students.

The latest in this line of extracurricular activities is the "**AVIYAAS**" talent festival currently being conducted by our students. This festival is being organized by the faculty Students Union with the support of the University administrative, academic and non-academic staff, the faculty Alumini and Public institutions.

The program is organized as an annual inter-batch competition covering four areas namely: Sports, Arts, Academia, and Social events. Many events under the categories of Sports, Arts, Academia, and Social have been planned:

Sports: Cricket, Football, Table Tennis, Badminton, Volleyball, Basketball, Carrom, Chess, Netball, Swimming, Marathon, Track Events (100M, 200M, 400M)

Arts: Drawing, Photography, Singing, Solo & Group Dance, Song Composition, Drama, Short film, Meme creation

Academia: Debate, Wordsmith (Short story, Poem, Creative Writing), Best Speaker, Best Tutor, Quiz Competition, Spell Master

Social: Blood Donation campaign, Medical Camp, Beach cleaning & Ocean protection club promotion, School Development Project.

Points are being allocated for each event, which will culminate in an overall point for each category. The batch which obtains the highest combined points will be awarded the Champions trophy and their batch name will be inscribed on an Honors board placed within the faculty premises.
