Triumph in Transdisciplinary Solutions: Faculty of Agriculture Students Claim Top Honors in SciDimplomatrix23 Competition



The seven students from the 2020/2021 batch of the Faculty of Agriculture secured first place in the SciDimplomatrix23 competition conducted by the Genetics and Molecular Biology Society. The Department of Agricultural Biology staff and the Director/CMR guided the students in identifying and preparing posters that presented innovative transdisciplinary solutions to prevailing crises. In this context, two issues were identified: 1) Automated detector and controller for insect pests, and 2) Conflict between elephants and humans. For this competition, 100 posters were received from universities across Sri Lanka.

Initially, the two posters submitted by the EUSL Agricultural students were selected among 16 finalists. Finally, at the competition held on February 3, 2024, it was declared that the posters submitted by the EUSL Agricultural students secured first place.

11th Research Forum on 'Community-Based Intervention 2024' Showcases Innovative Research

The 11th Research Forum on 'Community-Based Intervention 2024' was held in dual mode on the 26th of March, 2024. Moderated by Dr. G. Louis Jeyaraj, a specialist in pharmaceuticals at Sioul Pharma API & Analytical Consulting, LLC, USA, the forum was led by Dr. Rodney Fernando, Director of the Centre for Multidisciplinary Research (CMR).







The forum featured a guest lecture by Dr. G. Louis Jeyaraj, who provided an insightful overview of the drug development and approval process, with a focus on active pharmaceutical ingredients. U.S. Embassy Officials Guide Eastern University on Visa Processes

The delegates from China and key officers led by the Registrar, EUSL visited the proposed site in the university to establish the 'Confucius Unit,' which has already been established at the University of Colombo and several locations worldwide.






CENSARM (CENTER FOR SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURE AND RESOURCE MANAGEMENT)


