FACULTY OF SCIENCE

Programme Reviews 2024: Ensuring Excellence of the Faculty of Science

Two separate programme reviews for the B.Sc. (Honours) Degree Programmes, Cluster B (3) of the Physical Science and Cluster A (3) of the Biological Science, Faculty of Science, Eastern University, Sri Lanka, were conducted by external reviewers from other universities on the 15th and 16th of October and the 6th and 7th of November 2024, respectively.

On the first day, the review teams engaged with key university officials, including the Vice Chancellor, Director/CQA, Dean of the Faculty, Heads of Departments, Senior and Junior Academics, Administrative Staff, Non-Academic Staff, Academic Support Staff, and Technical Staff, gathering vital insights. They also conducted site visits to the Academic Affairs Division, Examination Division, Chemistry, Botany, and Zoology Departments, Common Canteen, Hostels, and Hostel Canteens to assess facilities.

On the second day, discussions were held with the Director/Student Support Service & Welfare (SSSW), SAR/Student Affairs, Wardens, Canteen Committee Staff, Student Counsellors, Academic Counsellors, Directors of SDC, CGU, UBL, and Coordinator/GEE, along with students and alumni to understand their perspectives. The team also visited and interacted with staff at the Career Guidance Unit, CICT, Library, FQAC, DELT, Health Centre, Physical Education Unit, and Gym.

Additionally, the teams observed lectures to ensure that academic standards and student learning experiences align with quality benchmarks. The reviews marked a significant step toward continuous improvement in higher education, especially in the Science stream at Eastern University, Sri Lanka.

Advancing Science to Address Regional Challenges

The Faculty of Science at Eastern University, Sri Lanka, successfully hosted its Annual Research Session (ARS) on November 28, 2024, under the theme "Scientific Approaches to Overcome Regional Challenges."
