The Community Outreach Science Unit (COSU) of the Faculty of Science, Eastern University, Sri Lanka, successfully conducted the first Awareness Programme on Answering Methodologies for the GCE (A/L) Examination on 8th July 2025, from 8 am. to 3 pm., simultaneously in Trincomalee at Sri Shanmuga Hindu Ladies College and R.K.M. Sri Koneshwara Hindu College.

The sessions aimed to raise awareness among students on effective answering techniques for Science Stream subjects and to highlight common mistakes in examination responses, with reference to the marking schemes of each subject. Students from both the 2025 and 2026 GCE (A/L) batches actively participated, with the support from their subject teachers. The programme was enriched by expert resource persons, including Prof. M. Thanihaichelvan (Physics) from the University of Jaffna, and from Eastern University, Sri Lanka, Prof. M. Sithamparesan (Chemistry), Dr. A.J.M. Harris (Biology), and the Prof. P. The session focused on identifying challenges, improving system functionality, and ensuring that student feedback is efficiently collected and utilized for enhancing academic quality across faculties.



Standardizing Practical Assessments: Workshop on Guidelines for Conducting Practical Examinations

Elango, Director of the CQA, the workshop focused on best practices, procedural consistency, and quality assurance measures, marking a key step in strengthening practical assessment procedures and supporting academic excellence at SVIAS.

Enhancing Assessment Practices: Workshop on Developing the Assessment Blueprint

The Centre for Quality Assurance of Eastern University, Sri Lanka, successfully organized a workshop on the Development of the Assessment Blueprint and Constructive Alignment at the Boardroom of EUSL. Held on 16 September 2025, the session aimed to guide participants in designing effective assessment blueprints that enhance validity, quality, and support student learning through the constructive alignment of teaching, learning, and evaluation.

The workshop brought together key stakeholders involved in curriculum design, including Chairpersons of Faculty Curriculum Development Committees (CDC), two senior members from each Faculty CDC, and Coordinators of Faculty Quality Assurance Cells. 
The workshop provided staff members with a lively and engaging environment to develop essential English language abilities, empowering them to communicate more effectively within the university setting.


